GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Child must be age eleven or younger.
- 2. The speech will be prepared by the contestant, advice allowed as well as changes or improvements are allowed.
- 3. Quotes must be cited.
- 4. The official topic must be stated at the beginning of speech.
- 5. Speech must be at least two minutes long, and not exceeding three minutes.
- 6. A signed Parent/Guardian registration form must be included with each contestant's submission.

CONTEST RULES:

- 1. Timing starts right after topic is stated.
- 2. Presentation text and/or notes are permissible.
- 3. Microphones are allowed.
- 4. A Drawing administered by the contest chair will determine speaking order.
- 5. Contestants will be judged on poise, content of speech, presentation, and overall effectiveness.
- 6. Three points will be deducted for failure to announce the official topic at the beginning of the speech.
- 7. Two points will be deducted for each fifteen seconds or portion over or under the allotted time.
